In the last five decades TKII have grown to become one of the most trusted names in the fields of, Open Cast Mining & Bulk Material Handling Systems, Sugar Plants & Machinery , Industrial Boilers & Power plants and Cement Plants & Machinery.

The purpose of this visit was to gain deeper insights into the course of Project Management. The students were guided by Mr.Shripad Khire, Manager PPC at TKII.
